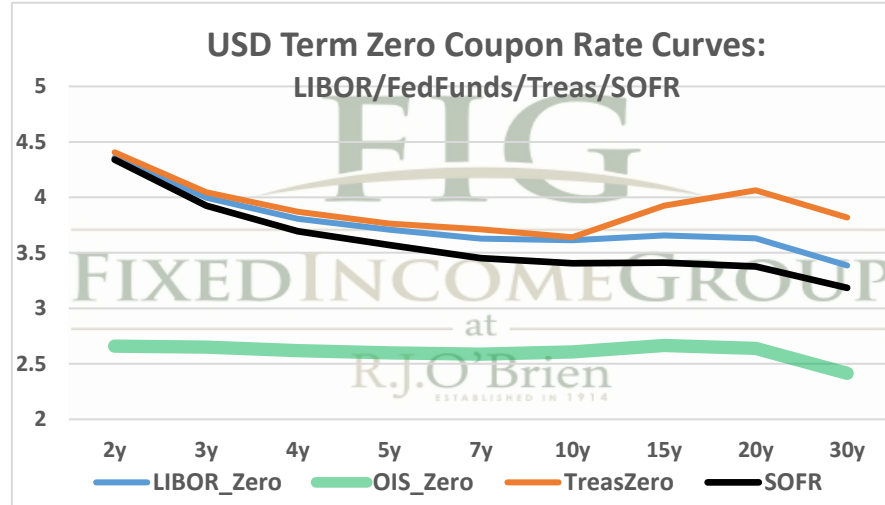
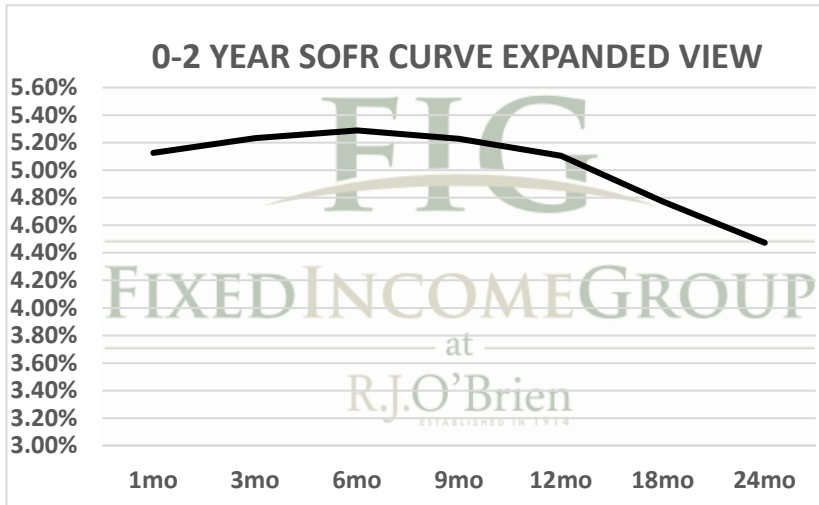


THE STIR CURVE: Distributed by The Fixed Income Group at RJ O'Brien
